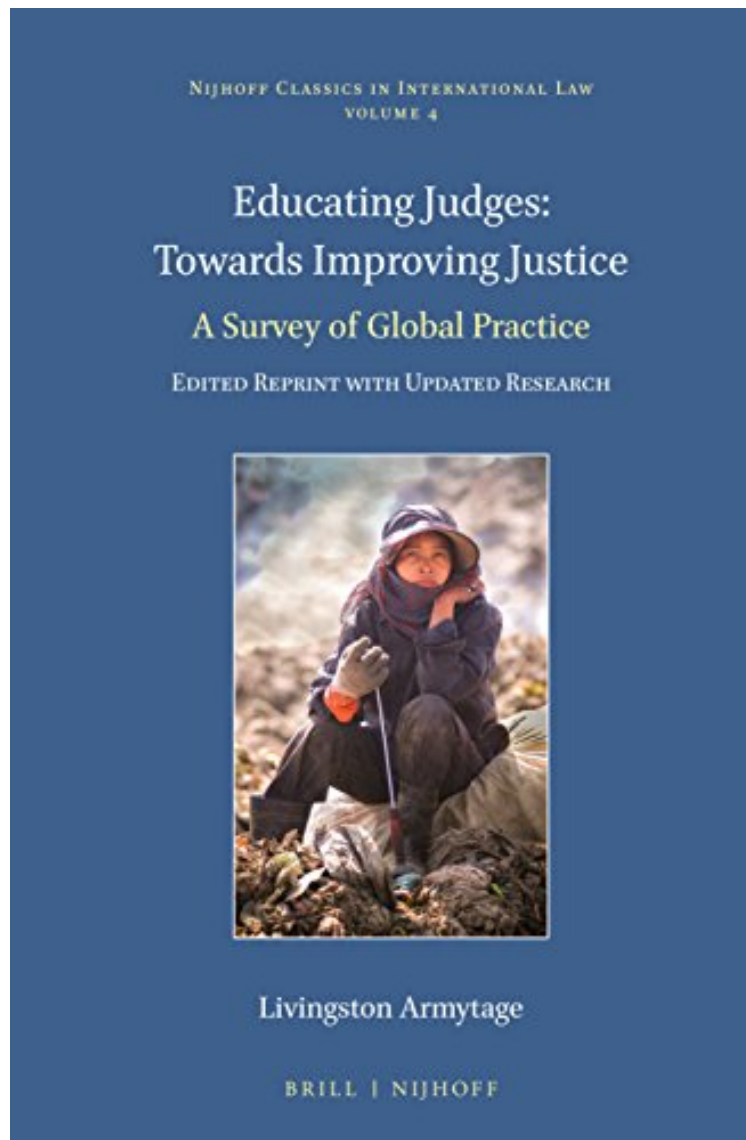


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## **Educating Judges: Towards Improving Justice: A Survey of Global Practice (Nijhoff Classics in International Law)**
