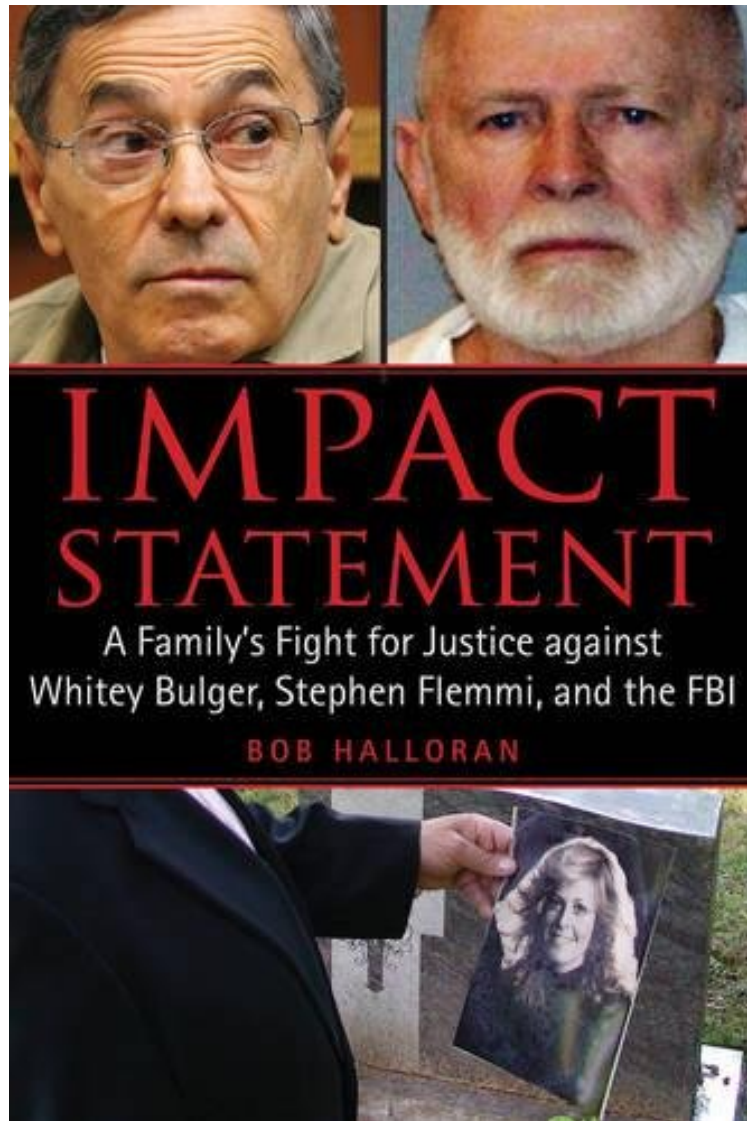

Many stories have been told about the murders Whitey and Stephen The Rifleman Flemmi committed, and the tacit permission they received from the FBI.
